Hudson Valley's nonprofit silvopasture farm & farm stand reopens for the 2023 season

March 24, 2023 (Goshen, NY) After a long winter, All One One All (AOOA) founders Ariane and Alix Daguin are again ready to share the joy of fresh produce, delicious food, workshops, tours, and all things farm-related with the community starting April 1. The 14-acre non-profit silvopasture regenerative farm is a place for people to gather for a great meal, learn about the importance of responsible agriculture, and participate in educational workshops that connect them to their local productive landscape and support community building.

The AOOA Farm Stand will be serving soups, salads, sandwiches, and baked goods that celebrate the bounty of their and other local farms. They also sell pastured eggs, dried teas, an abundance of seasonal produce, and farm goods such as honey, housemade syrups, and wool from their livestock endangered heritage Karakul sheep. Among AOOA's first workshops of the year will be a chocolate making workshop for kids lead by award-winning master chocolatier Jacques Torres, a family-friendly natural Easter egg dyeing party, private beekeeping lessons, an herbal medicine workshop, and a hands-on egg cookery class with Ariane.

New to the farm this year is a self-guided Farm Scavenger Hunt activity designed to be a fun way for children and families to get outdoors and explore the farm while learning about regenerative agriculture.

This summer, the farm will also begin the on-site production of small-batch distilled and macerated spirits using ingredients from its seasonal harvest. They will also be a regular vendor at the Goshen Farmer's Market every Friday from May 19 through November 17, where they will be selling seasonal ready-to-eat soups, sandwiches, and salads made from the best high-quality and local ingredients.

"We are excited to welcome back our loyal customers and introduce new visitors to the beauty and bounty of our farm," says Alix, project director at AOOA. "The entire team and I are dedicated to changing the way people think about food, so we look forward to any opportunity to share our passion for farming and community with visitors from near and far!"
